Meet Our Medical Director

Peter Selwyn, M.D., M.P. H. has been Leeway's Medical Director since the facility opened in October of 1995.

He is currently Professor of Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, and Epidemiology and Population Health, and also Chairman of the Department of Family and Social Medicine, at Montefiore Medical Center and Albert Einstein College of Medicine in the Bronx, New York. He is also Director of Community Health and Wellness at Montefiore Medical Center, and directs Montefiore's Office of Community Health.

Dr. Selwyn received his B.A. degree from Swarthmore College in 1976, his M.D. degree from Harvard Medical School in 1981, and his M.P.H. in epidemiology from Columbia University in 1989. He completed his clinical training at Montefiore Medical Center in 1984, and in his subsequent role as Medical Director of the Montefiore Substance Abuse Treatment Program, was involved in some of the earliest studies of AIDS and substance abuse at the beginning of the AIDS epidemic. He was Associate Director of the AIDS Program at the Yale School of Medicine from 1992-1998, and returned to Montefiore in his current role in 1999.

Dr. Selwyn has written over 160 articles, book chapters, monographs, and reviews and is author of a memoir about the early AIDS epidemic, "Surviving the Fall: The Personal Journey of an AIDS Doctor" (Yale University Press).
